## About Living the Dream Foundation

Hello Gang Members,

I want to thank you for offering to help with our Meal Packing Event on Sunday, Nov. 27<sup>th</sup>.

I have asked the coordinators to reserve space for 20 streetrods for those who want to volunteer, and those who want to cheer us on. Each volunteer shift is 1 hour, and if you get caught up in the excitement, you can also do a 2<sup>nd</sup> hour. It is fun, believe me. My daughter and I participated in one in San Luis Obispo where the group packed 40,000 meals in 4 hours. It takes a lot of volunteers, team spirit, and everyone has a good time. Anyone can register ... even grandkids... Invite them to come too!

The meals we will be packing are a one quart-size package. Each one contains the dry ingredients for 6 nutritionally complete meals, with each meal costing 25 cents. The meal, works to help reverse the effects of malnutrition and starvation. One-third of the meals will stay right here in San Diego for the food bank and other shelters. The remaining two-thirds will be sent to Haiti and Tanzania.

The 5 Dream Dinners Stores in San Diego will host the event in the Sysco Warehouse Parking lot in Poway. The event starts at Noon, and we can caravan up there together. I will have a sign-up sheet at the meeting, or you can call/email me. Pre-registration to work is requested so that we can all get a time slot together.
