CARB Tire inflation Regulations

9/1/2010

On August 31, 2010 the California Office of Administrative Law (OAL) approved a final regulatory order issued by California Air Resources Board (CARB) entitled: Regulations to Reduce Greenhouse Gas Emissions from Vehicles Operating with Under Inflated Tires. The new regulation was approved with an early implementation date of tomorrow, September 1, 2010.

WHO IS AFFECTED: The regulation applies to all automotive services providers, defined as “any business or government or private vehicle fleet maintenance provider that performs or offers to perform automotive maintenance or repair service”.

CAN A SERVICE PROVIDER CHARGE FOR THE SERVICE: Yes, if they provide a written estimate **first**, just like any other service.

VEHICLE WITH A GVWR EXCEEDING 10,000 LBS: Exempt

PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE: An automotive service provider that fails to comply with the regulations is punishable by fines up to \$25,000 and nine months imprisonment if the violation was the result of negligence and up to \$75,000 and one year imprisonment if the violation was intentional.

The roster is cool – there is a bar of car club logos there – if you position your curser on the logos , then either move the curser to the right or the left on your computer screen the logos will scroll – click on any of the logos and if that particular club has a website you will be linked to it. It’s a new baby, so I’m sure there will be bugs to work out,

so bare with us – we want this to be a place where, not only the seasoned vets of the car club world, but new potential members can go and get informed with what’s happening on the car scene in San Diego.
